Quinsbel Royals Educational Complex School is a small village school located in Abeadze Dominase, Central Region, Ghana. The school is devoted to providing a safe and rich academic environment for children living in the immediate rural area, ranging from preschool through Junior High. The school was established in September 2011, with 10 boys, 17 girls, a teacher and 2 attendants. With the relentless drive of the school proprietor, Mr. Francis Quainoo, the school received official registration and recognition from the Ghana Municipal Education Office in July 2013.

In September 2015, the school held its first Graduation with Speech and Prize Giving Day activities. Two years later, the school participated in an Inter-School Kids Competition at the regional level and placed second out of 15 schools. Many of the initial QREC students gained admission for further studies at the secondary level, proceeding to the senior high school, while others took to dressmaking and other apprenticeship opportunities.

By 2019, the school boasted a student body of 200 pupils with a staff strength of fourteen. After the COVID pandemic and the national economic crisis in Ghana, the student population reduced to 120.

After visiting the rural school during a 2019 Ghana tour, a group of Abby Travels tourists quickly identified the need and jumped at the opportunity to donate school supplies. They came with pens, pencils, erasers, crayons, notebooks, markers, workbooks, book bags, etc. Since then, each Abby Travels tour group now voluntarily brings a giving of school supplies and personal items (underwear and hygiene products for both girls and boys of all ages and sizes).

In 2022 Abby Travels made a donation of laptops, printer, software and networking equipment, and set up a computer lab at the school. Ongoing virtual technical support was also made available for troubleshooting.

Abby Travels is now committed to support the essential needs of the QREC students. **YOU can also make a difference through a donation.** 100% of the monetary donations will be used by Abby Travels to make purchases from Ghanaian suppliers, which will reduce transportation and shipping costs while boosting the local economy.
